and vaccine requirements, security advisories, translation services, lost document advice, coordination of medical and security evacuation, and assistance for other emergency services. Book your travel using the Synopsys corporate travel agent so that you can receive pre-trip advisories as well as outreach in the event of emergencies like natural disasters, political unrest and disease outbreaks.

Accessing Medical Care

For urgent or emergency medical care or dental injury while traveling outside your home country on business, call International SOS and they will coordinate with the corporate travel medical insurance, ideally guaranteeing payment on your behalf at the point of care. If you do not contact ISOS prior to accessing emergency or urgent care, you will pay out-of-pocket and submit claims for reimbursement. If you require emergency evacuation, the business travel medical/business travel accident insurance plan will pay evacuation expenses when coordinated and arranged by International SOS. For assistance with filing medical claims after returning home, contact <u>GBS.MBHRC.BenefitsAdmin@ajg.com</u>. For other claims such as lost baggage, create a ticket in Synopsys Assist or email <u>benefits@Synopsys.com</u>.

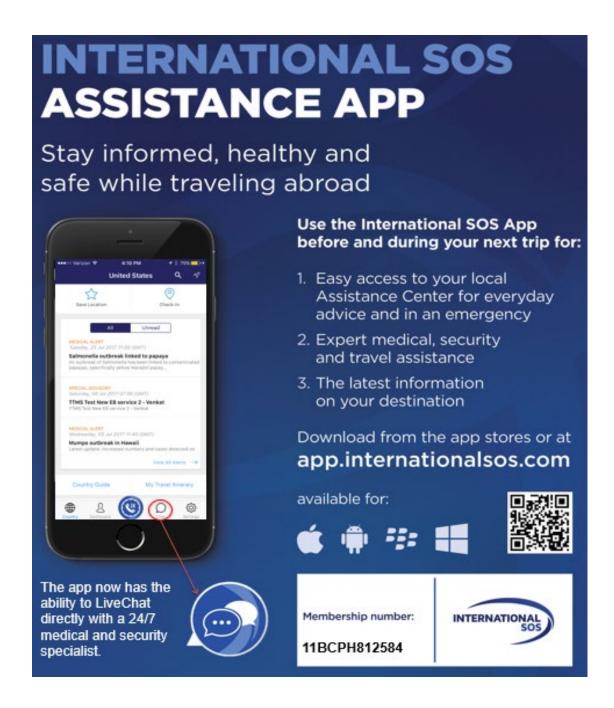

You will receive a confirmation email and most requests are fulfilled within 24-48 hours (letters issued normally each weekday morning, US time).
